- **They're going to eat** fried fish for Holy Friday.
- **She's going to study** English tomorrow.

É COMUM USAR A CONTRAÇÃO GONNA EM MÚSICAS E CONVERSAS INFORMAIS.

Ex. **We're gonna visit** you as soon as possible. (neste caso **NÃO** usamos a partícula TO depois de *gonna*)

LOOK THE DIFFERENCE: I will study. (eu estudarei)

I'm going to study. (eu vou estudar)

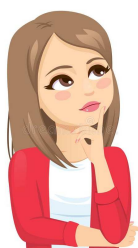
