3. **Some:** algum; frases afirmativas; substantivos contáveis/incontáveis
4. **Any:** a) frases afirmativas: qualquer  
b) frases negativas: nenhum  
c) frases interrogativas: algum
5. **A lot of:** muito/grande quantidade; para substantivos contáveis/incontáveis
6. **A few:** um pouco; substantivos contáveis
7. **A little:** um pouco; substantivos incontáveis
