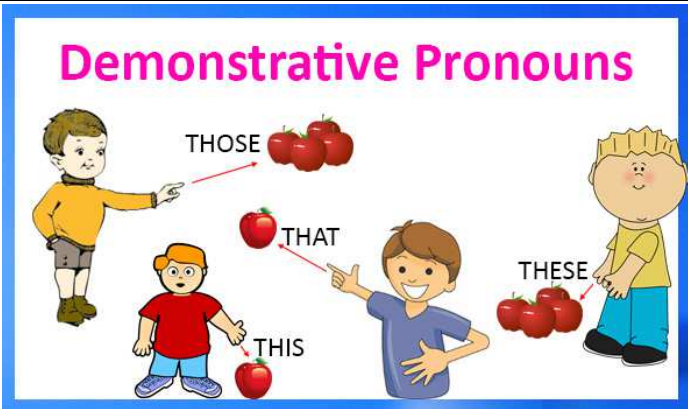
Students, esta semana daremos início ao estudo dos **pronomes demonstrativos**.
